



FINANCIAL UPDATE

TJH has been blessed financially by many faithful and generous donors through the years. We raised funds for the construction of TJH for about five years before we were able to build and open our doors to serve people in 2020. Over the past year, the vast majority of our operating expenses (about 84%) have gone toward supporting the programs that serve the guests of TJH. However, about

10% of our expenses were interest-only payments on the balance of our construction loan. We are continuing our Capital Campaign with the goal to raise \$250,000 by the end of 2022. This will enable us to become totally debt free and direct more funds into supporting our programs. While we did initially receive some large grants for construction, the bulk of our funding over the past three years of operating (about 80%) has come from individuals and churches. God has truly provided for TJH in many miraculous ways over the years. One such miracle came in the form of a grant to install solar panels on the property in the summer of 2020. This amazing gift continues to serve us by producing over 90% of the power for the home.



HOUSING CHALLENGES & THE NEXT STEP PROGRAM

Every guest of TJH faces a daunting challenge of finding suitable long-term housing after their stay. One factor that has greatly increased this burden in recent years is the high demand for rental housing. There simply are not enough rental units available and rental prices have continued to skyrocket beyond affordability. As TJH programs help to prepare our guests for this challenge, we have also been compelled to help the situation by creating our own affordable housing through our Next Step Program. Currently we own one singlefamily home that was donated to us and is made available to guests who are graduating from TJH. The Next Step Program provides an affordable, independent living situation while maintaining the connection to the resources and relationships at TJH. While the Next Step is not a permanent housing solution, it does give guests crucial additional time to find housing and save funds for rental fees like security deposits. We plan to own more of these homes in the future, but we would also like to expand the Next Step Program through strategic partnerships with local landlords.



Our first Next Step home has housed three families so far.
